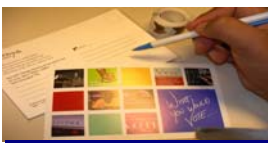

This past spring our Board of Directors announced an increase from \$1.8 million to \$3 million annually in our commitment to students. 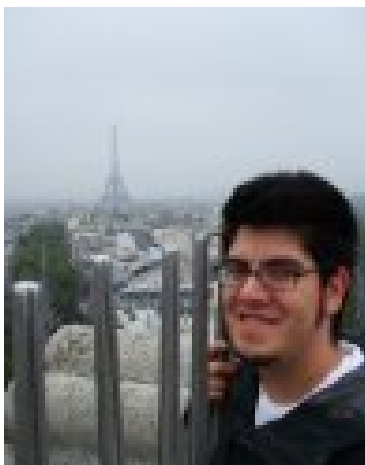
