PRESIDENT'S LAW ENFORCEMENT AWARDS

PURPOSE: To recognize at the annual LULAC Law Enforcement Breakfast as part of the LULAC Annual Federal Training Institution Conference, those individuals in law enforcement that have performed above and beyond the call of duty, thereby making extraordinary contributions or achievements in the improvement of productivity, efficiency, operational or program effectiveness; reduced or avoided cost; or creatively solved organizational or mission-related problems through the innovative use of information technology and other resources. Achievements recognized would be for the year 2006.

THE LULAC PRESIDENT'S AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN LAW ENFORCEMENT

- a. **Description:** The LULAC President's Award for Excellence in Law Enforcement is designed to recognize outstanding professional achievement by a law enforcement officer at either the federal, state, or local level.
- b. **Definition:** The term "law enforcement officer" means an employee whose primary duties are/were the investigation, apprehension, or detention of individuals suspected or convicted of offenses against the criminal laws of the United States.
- c. **Criteria:** All federal, state, and local law enforcement officers are eligible. The nominee must have demonstrated unusual courage or outstanding accomplishments in the field of law enforcement during the year 2006.

**THE LULAC PRESIDENT'S AWARD FOR EQUAL EMPLOYMENT
OPPORTUNITY IN LAW ENFORCEMENT**

- a. **Description:** The LULAC President's Award for Equal Employment Opportunity in Law Enforcement is designed to recognize the most significant contribution(s) to Equal Employment Opportunity.
- b. **Criteria:** This award is not restricted to EEO Program officials. A nomination may be for any manager and/or employee who has made significant contributions to the area of equal employment opportunity. These contributions could be in the areas of leadership, training opportunities, recruitment, conciliation, or other activity that enhances employment opportunities for women and minorities, especially Hispanics, within any organizational component of law enforcement agencies, bureau, or division during the year 2006.

**THE LULAC PRESIDENT'S AWARD FOR CAREER ENHANCEMENT
IN LAW ENFORCEMENT**

- a. **Description:** The LULAC President's Award for Career Enhancement in Law Enforcement is designed to recognize the most significant contribution or contributions by an employee to the career enhancement of other former or current law enforcement employees.
- b. **Criteria:** A nomination may be for any manager or employee who has made significant contributions to the career enhancement of law enforcement employees. These contributions could be in the areas of leadership, training, program development, program implementation, or any other activity that enhances career opportunities for lower grade employees during the year 2006.

**THE LULAC PRESIDENT'S COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD
IN LAW ENFORCEMENT**

- a. **Description:** The LULAC President's Community Service Award in Law Enforcement recognizes law enforcement employees for exceptionally outstanding service, who through his/her own initiative, has been instrumental in the development and implementation of new techniques and strategies that have resulted in the reduction of tension between minorities and non-minorities, especially Hispanics.
- b. **Criteria:** The LULAC President's Community Service Award in Law Enforcement recognizes individuals for exceptionally outstanding service and for incidents involving extraordinary contribution(s) to their law

enforcement agency and community in assisting in the resolution of differences, disputes, and/or conflicts that often escalate into violence during the year 2006.

LULAC PRESIDENT 'S LAW ENFORCEMENT AWARDS NOMINATION FORM

Agencies are encouraged to submit a single, best candidate for each of the four categories below, i.e., one candidate for excellence; one candidate for EEO; one candidate for career enhancement; and one candidate for community service.

Total description should not exceed two pages. Attach copies of documentation, i.e., letters of commendations, certificates of appreciation or any other form of recognition that supports the nomination.
