ORDER

The Court orders that the early-voting period for the December 12, 2006, special runoff election for Congressional District 23 shall extend through Saturday, December 9, 2006. Counties within the Congressional District shall have the discretion whether to hold weekend voting on Saturday, December 9, 2006 as provided under Texas Election Code § 85.006 and § 85.007. Counties in the Congressional District also have the discretion to extend early voting hours until 8p.m. on any of the early voting days. For purposes of this special runoff congressional election, the 72-hour posting requirement of Texas Election Code § 85.007(c) is suspended for each of the days included in the early voting period and the provision at Texas Election Code § 85.001(a) requiring the termination of early voting four (4) day prior to election day is also suspended.

This order supplements the prior court order on this matter filed in *LULAC v. Perry*, CA No. 2:03-CV-354 consolidated that is presently in the Eastern District of Texas.
